

Dear Partners,

We left out of Albuquerque on February 15, and returned home on May 18, after being on the road for three months, and having ministered the gospel of Jesus Christ to over 8,816 people. The outpouring of God was evident both in the sermon “Proclaim Announce Publicly,” as well as how it was received.

We have never seen another song impact the lives of so many people like the song, “I’ve Forgiven Me.” So many people have been weeping when they’ve come to realize that not only do they need to forgive others, but they need to also forgive *themselves* and to stop accusing themselves of the very sins that God had forgiven and chosen not to remember.



The new book, “My Life is a Storybook,” has been moving along well. Many people have been telling us how it has encouraged them by hearing the way God has moved in our lives, and that it also reminded them that they too have a story that they need to go and tell the world as well.

We have been given the **green light** to build the Discipleship Center. We will be focusing our efforts now on laying down the foundation. Please keep us in prayer as we look for a cement company that would give us a reasonable price. The estimated cost to complete the building is \$200,000. We have already achieved the 1st phase of \$50,000, which will be used to install the plumbing and the cement flooring. We are now working on the next phase of \$50,000 which will purchase the building. The last 2 phases of \$50,000 will be used for interior purposes. We are believing for this amount to come in before the end of the year.



We want to introduce you to our newest missionary, **Chuck Andrews**. He was able to go into the prisons and the churches in Texas with us. Please keep him in prayer as he is in training to become a Senior Missionary.

I just wanted you to know, my son told me that your words spoke to him as if you were talking to him. We are so blessed to have someone who has been down the same road as many of God's children have been and can give them some hope of a life out of prison. I just wanted to say thank for your service and may God bless you and your family. I'm going to order my son your books you have written for him to read. Again "Thank You" for your service.

What an incredible year that we have had so far. On June 9th we head to the northwest part of the United States. We are looking forward to visiting with our missionaries and our brothers and sisters that are behind the walls. Thank you for helping us reach others.
