The person we are looking for, must have Christian values and principles, strong leadership skills, the ability to multi-task and have great Public Relations skills.

Eddie has been preaching a message called, ***Come Out of the Grave Clothes***, and lives are being touched and changed. The new CD, ***Mercy for My Apology***, is being well received. People especially love the songs ***Jewels***, ***Overflow***, and ***Hello Goodbye***. This is Eddie's ***39th*** CD. To us, this is a testament of how good God really is towards us. He continues to give us songs that minister to people and cause them to cry out to God.

***Awesome Testimony*** – “Julian Cisneros is a miracle from God. He was in a car wreck when he was 4 months old that left him completely wheel chair bound and completely dependent on others for care. He is 17 years old now and had major back surgery in October of 2016. They had to put metal rods and screws in his back. The doctors told us he might not make it through the surgery and that it was a 50 percent chance that he would not make it, but we had no choice. We had to do it because his ribs were already pressing into his heart causing heart trouble and we had to get his back straight. Throughout his whole life, if he was in pain or crying, and I'm talking about even for surgeries, if he was hurting, all we had to do was turn on some gospel music and it would calm him. One of his favorite songs is *"His Wounds"* by Eddie B. He loves it. Every time he heard gospel music he would move his arm and whole body like he was really enjoying it, and that was what we were used too especially at church, but they told us he would probably never be able to enjoy his gospel music like that anymore because of all the metal rods in his back. On the way home from the hospital we played his song that he loved by Eddie B. and he stuck his hand up in the air and moved one time and kind of stopped like it was hurting him, but praise God he tried though and still did it. Then we had the pleasure of having Eddie B. back at our church and I asked him to do Julian's favorite song and he did, and Julian went crazy over it and loved it. You couldn't even tell he had any metal or rods in his back; he was twisting and waving his arm in the air. I know it's a sweet peace of Jesus that comes over him when he hears his gospel music.”
